Venue

The school will take place at Hotel Hullu Poro, at Levi fell in Lapland at 67.81°N, 24.81°E, 800 km north of Helsinki. Kittilä airport is a 15-minute drive from Levi resort (15 km). Finnair flies between Helsinki and Kittilä all year round. During the winter season, daily flights are available. Norwegian has three weekly flights. An airport shuttle bus runs from Kittilä airport to Levi after all flights throughout the year. The bus also runs from Levi to the airport before the flights. Alternatively, it is possible to fly to Rovaniemi, the capital of Finnish Lapland, and take an airport Taxi or bus (137 km) to the venue.

The venue has excellent lecture hall facilities and vast experience of arranging conferences and meetings, Residents and speakers will be accommodated in comfortable single and double rooms. The course will provide breakfast, lunch, coffee breaks and dinner. Daily sauna is included and there is a workout center at the venue. A get-together dinner is arranged Sunday evening, and a Gala Dinner at a restaurant nearby.

There will be a great opportunities for daily outdoor activities 2-3 hours during the course. Consequently, the lectures will start a bit earlier in the morning and continue a bit later than usual. Within a short walking distance there are cross-country skiing tracks, downhill skiing slopes (a venue for World Cup alpine skiing), snow walking paths, exotic shopping experiences, snowmobile excursions, husky safaris, and above all: the unique exotic Lapland. The schedule will enable a half day sponsored outdoor activities on Tuesday.
