



The CCP (Incorporation) Act in 1971

CEYLON COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS

Act No. 9 of 1971. AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE CEYLON COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS-

[27th February, 1971.]

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Ceylon College of Physicians (Incorporation) Act.

Incorporation of the Ceylon College of Physicians.

2. On and after the 27th day of February, 1971, such and so many persons as are now members of the Ceylon College of Physicians (hereinafter referred to as "the College") or shall hereafter be admitted members of the College shall be, and become a Corporation with perpetual succession under the name of "The Ceylon College of Physicians " (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") and by that name may sue and be sued in all courts, and shall have full power and authority to have and to use a common seal and to change and alter the same at their will and pleasure.

Corporation and shall hold office until the first annual general meeting of the Corporation.

5. (1) It shall be lawful for the Power to make Corporation, from time to time, at any rules. general meeting and by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the members present and voting, to make rules, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, for the admission, withdrawal and expulsion of members, and for the management of the affairs of the Corporation and the accomplishment of its objects. Such rules when made may, at a like meeting and in like manner be altered, added to, amended or rescinded.




















FELLOWSHIP OF THE CEYLON COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS

clarify health related issues.






