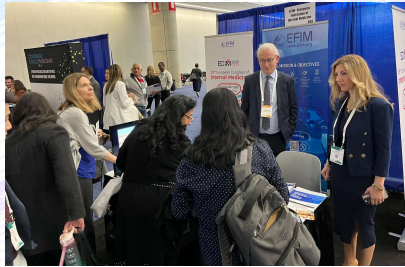

Article 12: Proceedings, quorums and votes



Membership categories	Base fee	Votes (on a country level)
Very small members < 200	525 €	1
Small members 201 - 500	1.050 €	1
Medium members 501 - 1000	1.575 €	2
Large Members 1001 - 2300	2.100 €	3
Extra Large Members > 2301	2.625 €	4

abstentions shall not be taken into account and, in the case of a written vote, blank and mutilated votes shall not be counted in the votes cast;

all votes on appointments in the Executive Committee or other personal matters shall be taken by a secret ballot, unless the Executive Committee asked for an open vote when there are no conflicts of interest; all other votes are public.

in case of elections, where none of the candidates obtains a majority of the votes cast, further voting rounds will be organised until a candidate obtains a majority

EFIM Bylaws – 2.6 Executive Committee Officers Profile

- 6) commit to comply with the statutes and internal regulations (“By-Laws”) of EFIM.
- 7) have not reached the statutory retirement age under the applicable national law of their country of residence (main residence for tax purposes and employment), on the day of the appointment.
- 8) specifically for President-Elect, not reaching the statutory retirement age under the applicable national law of their country of residence (main residence for tax purposes and employment), on the day of the scheduled appointment as President.
- 9) not be sitting as a President or Chair of another organization.

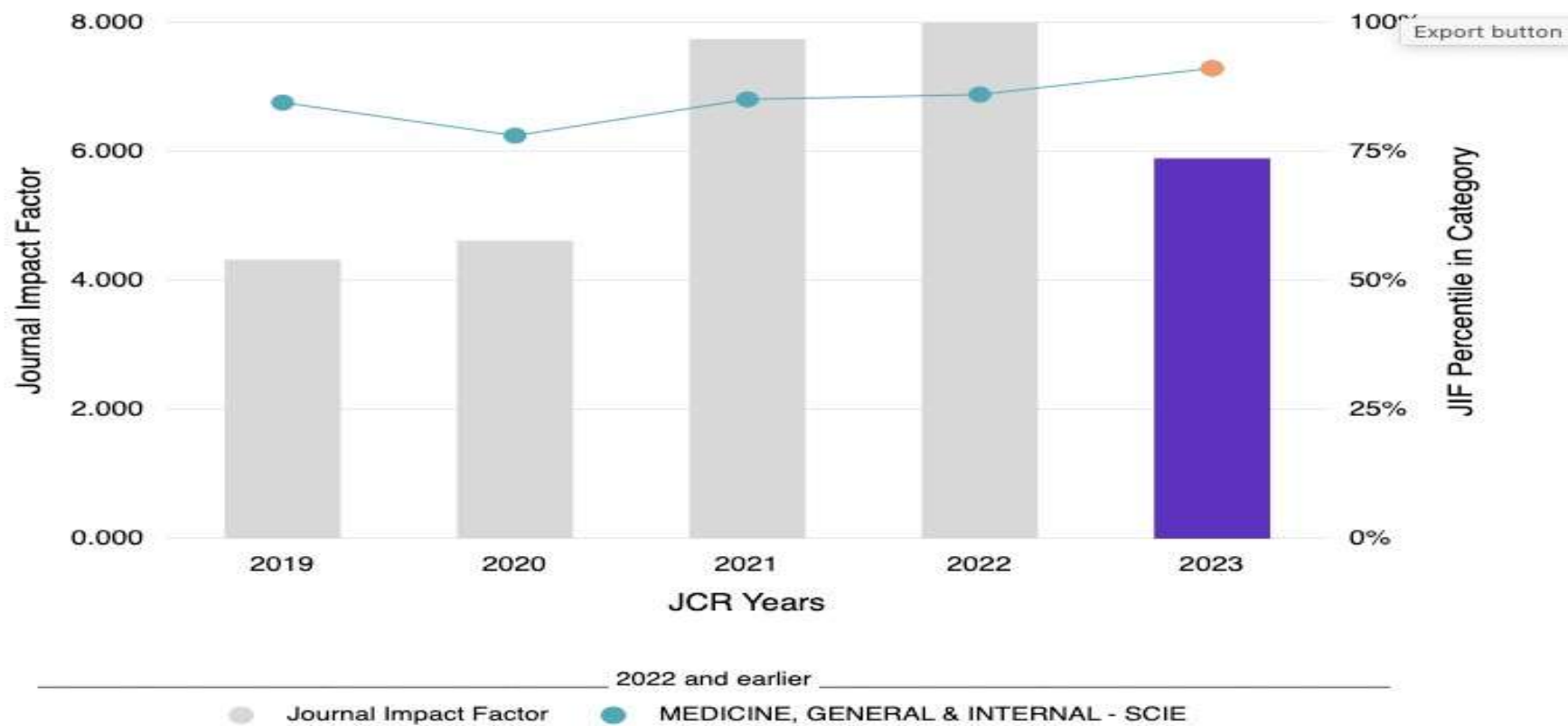

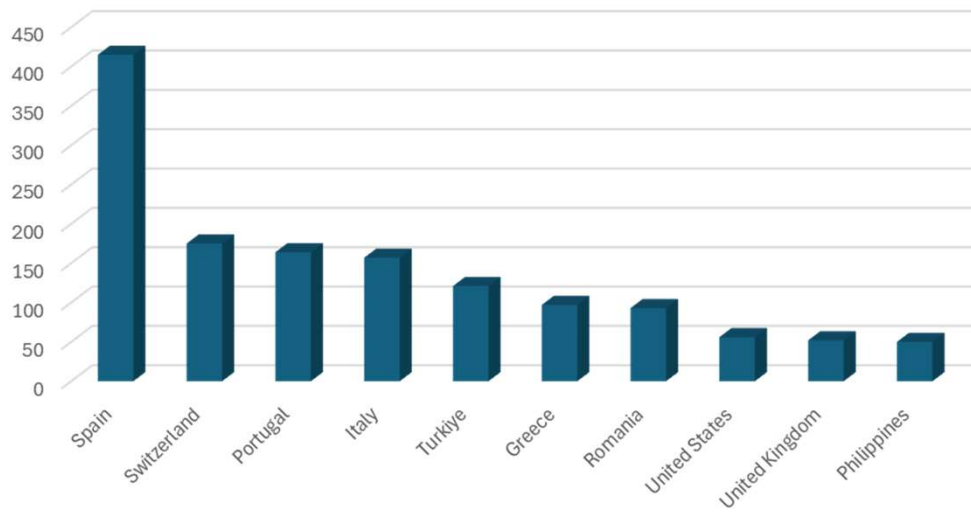

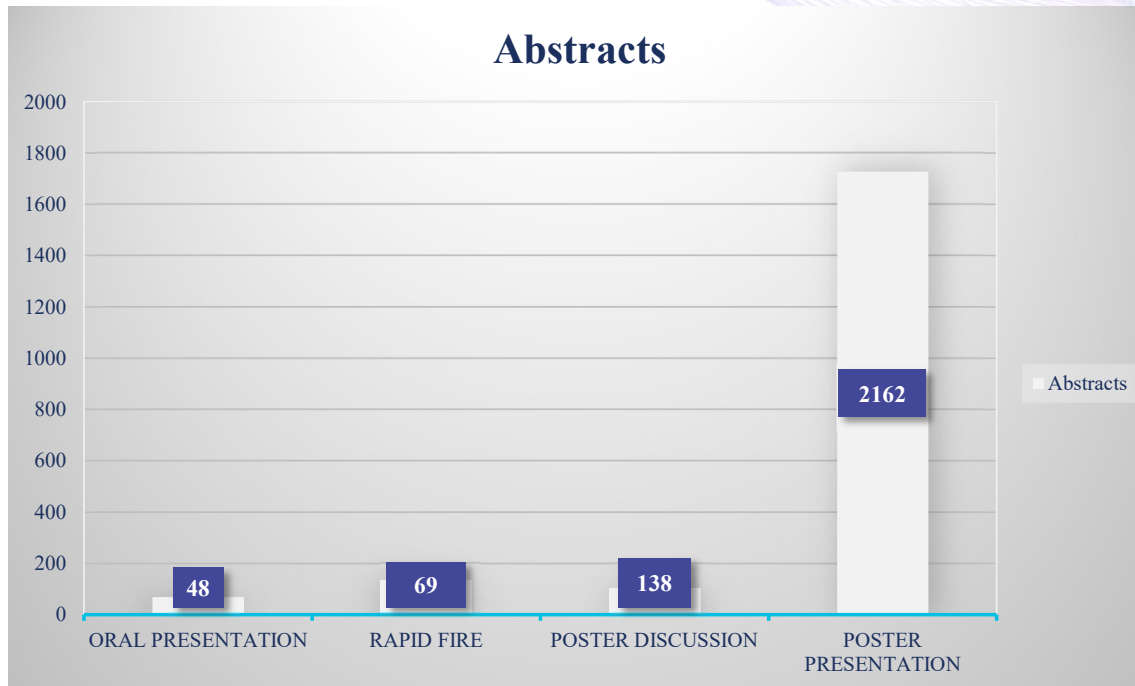
