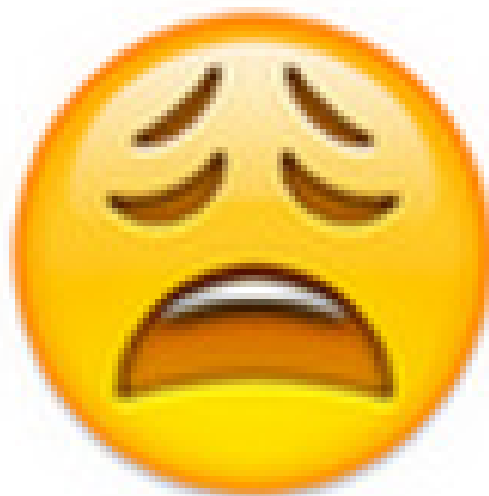

Chart illustrating the 3 domains of physician well-being, with each domain reciprocally influencing the others.



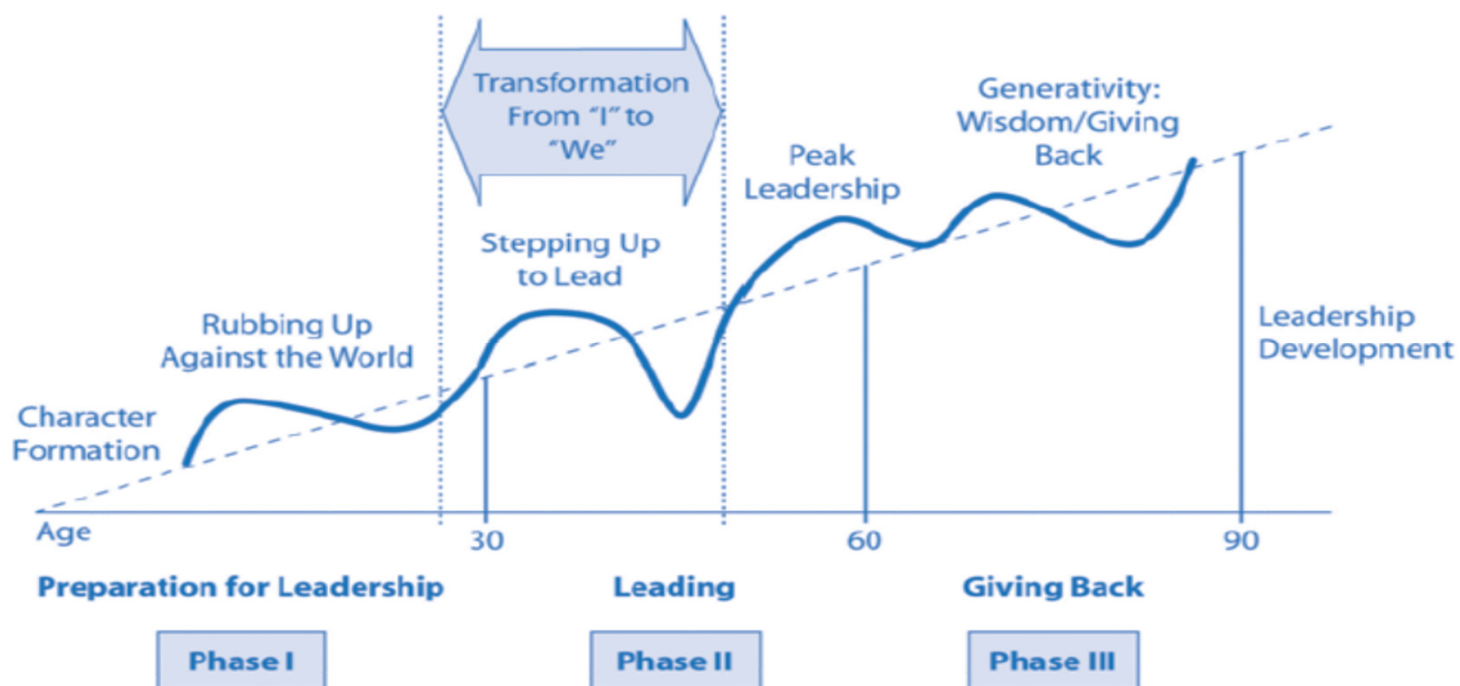

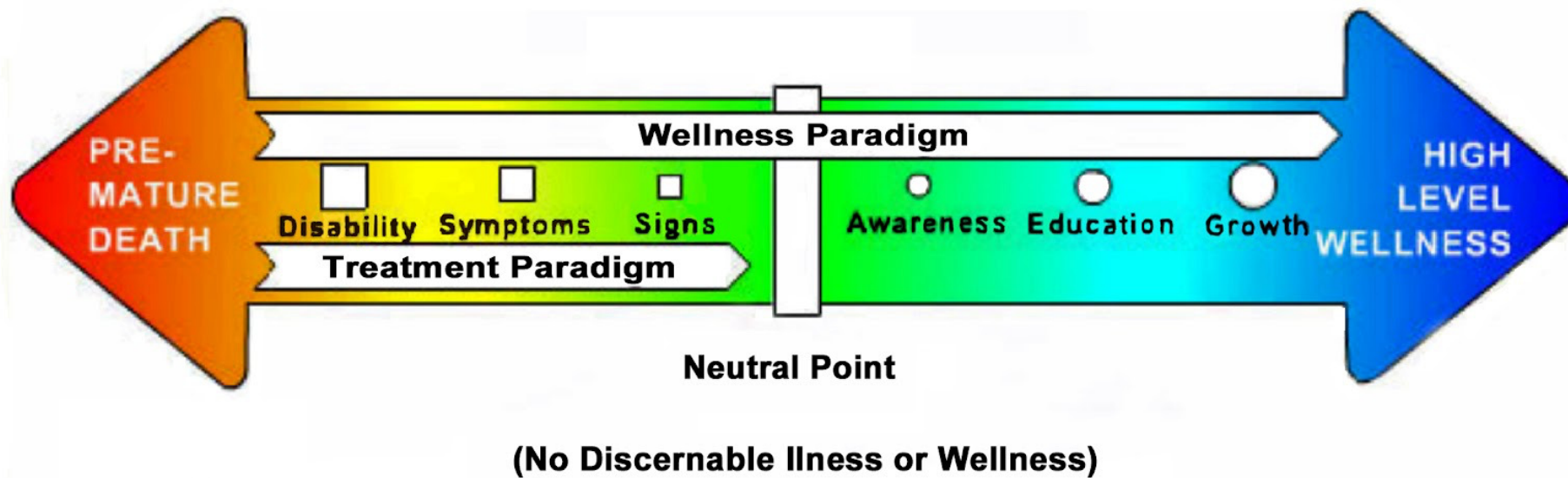


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THE ILLNESS-WELLNESS CONTINUUM

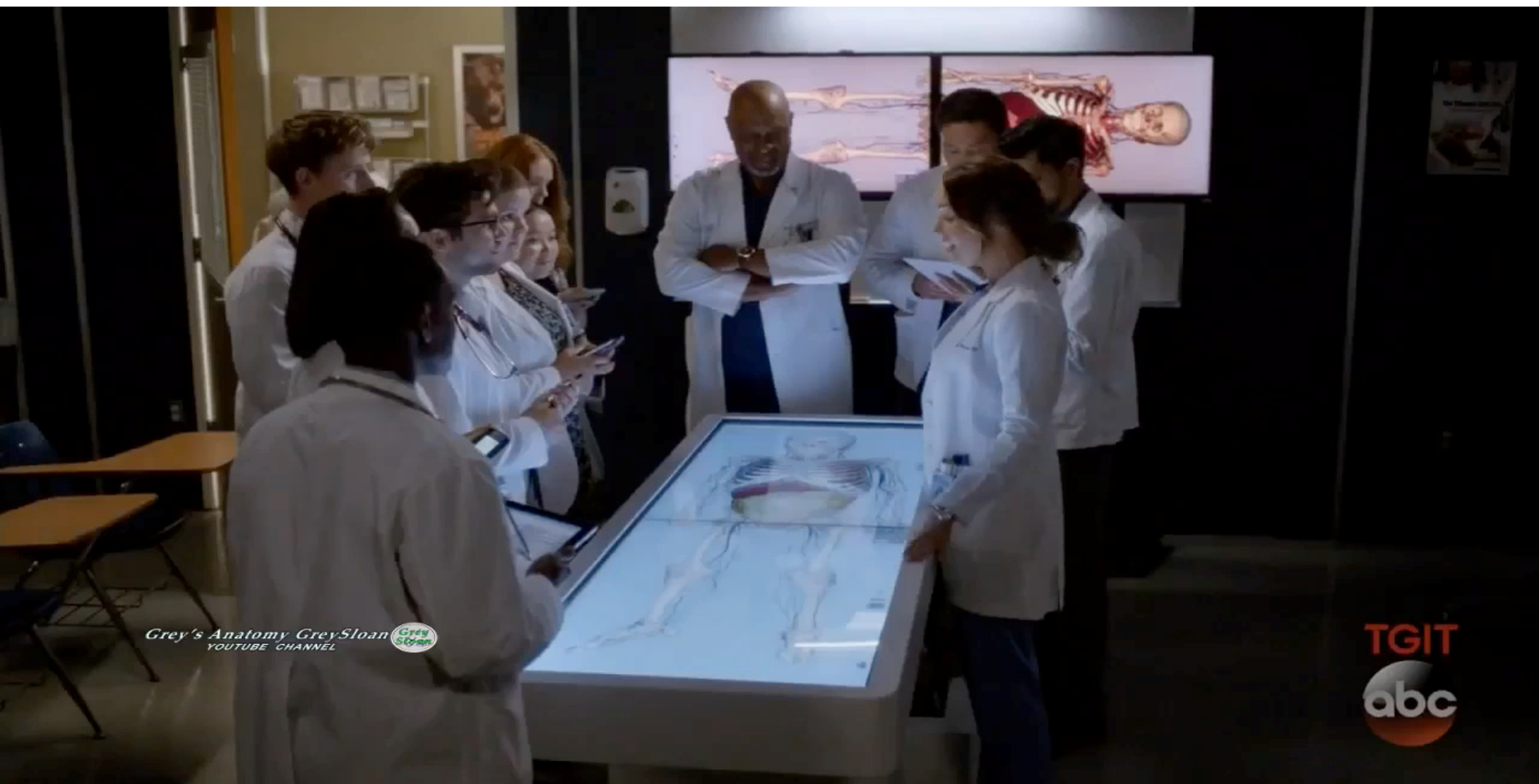

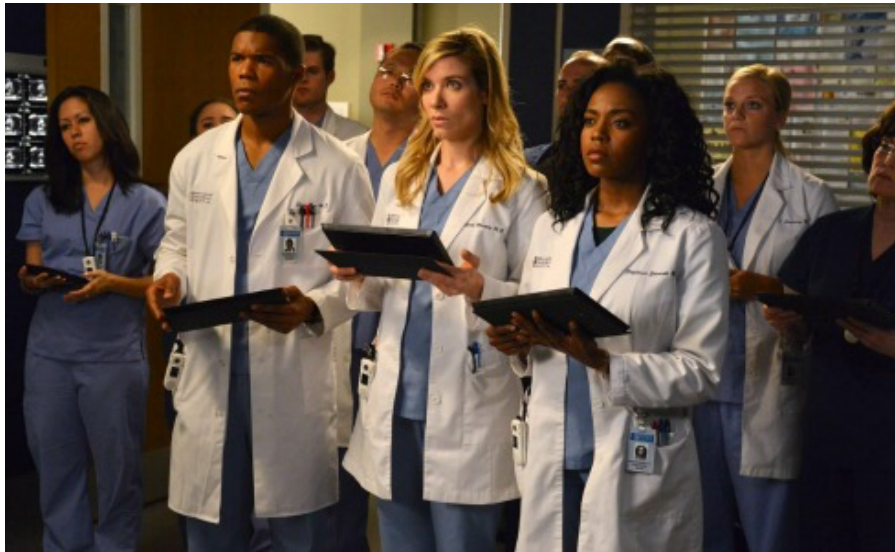
