



### **1.** The University General Hospital of Alexandroupolis

## (for the afternoon hands-on workshops)

The hands-on workshops will be held in the University General Hospital of Alexandroupolis which has all the necessary spaces and equipment for the needs of the Summer School as it has several Laboratories and Clinical Rooms. Recently, advanced educational equipment based on smart computing technologies, virtual reality, and three-dimensional digital presentation has been installed.

The University General Hospital of Alexandroupolis operates in a modern building complex adjacent to the facilities of the Department. It is the largest hospital in terms of useful surface area ever constructed in Greece and is designed to meet the needs of the broader region of Eastern Macedonia and Thrace. The total capacity of the hospital amounts to 673 beds.

The University General Hospital of Alexandroupolis is part of the Medical School of the Democritus University of Thrace. The Medical School comprises a total of  $\cdot$  7 Fields,  $\cdot$  52 accredited Laboratories,  $\cdot$  and 33 University Clinics. The Department offers a comprehensive undergraduate program in Medicine with theoretical training and clinical practice, 22 postgraduate study programs, and supports doctoral and postdoctoral research programs. The educational needs of the Medical School are covered by 109 Professors, 7 Teaching Staff members and 16 Special Teaching Staff members.

The level of healthcare services provided by the Medical School of the Democritus University of Thrace instils a significant sense of security in the population of the broader border region, while it manages to attract patients from other areas of Greece. The University Hospital in Alexandroupolis offers excellent infrastructure and creates the necessary conditions for high-quality healthcare services.





**By Air** 

The Alexandroupolis International Airport "Dimokritus" (AXD), with its modern facilities, ensures efficient and comfortable arrivals and departures. It is located approximately 7 km east of the city center.

Regular flights are operated to/from several cities in the world: Istanbul (Turkey), Frankfurt (Germany), Larnaca (Cyprus) and some Greek cities: Athens, Thessaloniki, Rhodes, etc.



By car

Situated approximately 800 km north of Athens and 300 km east of Thessaloniki, Alexandroupolis is well-connected by road, with a network of highways, such as the Egnatia Odos motorway, facilitating smooth travel within the region and beyond. This thoroughfare spans from the western port city of Igoumenitsa to the Turkish border, providing a well-connected route to the city. The city's strategic location along key transportation routes enhances its accessibility, providing delegates with convenient and reliable options for ground transportation.



By bus

Regular bus services facilitate travel between Alexandroupolis and various cities in Greece, including Athens, Thessaloniki, and Kavala. Operated by KTEL, the national bus company, tickets for bus transportation can be acquired at designated bus stations or through online booking platforms.


