# The MRCP(UK) Diploma Examination



- Largest postgraduate examination in internal medicine in the world
  - Part 1 knowledge based assessment
  - Part 2 knowledge based assessment
  - Includes, unlike USA equivalents, an assessment of bedside clinical skills, PACES.
- Mandatory in UK training, but sat in many other countries.
- Over 25000 candidates per annum globally in over 25 countries.




#### MRCP(UK) Specialist Level Examinations

#### MRCP(UK) Specialty Certificate exams (specialty training)

- a. Nine different Specialty Certificate Exams (SCEs)
- b. Two pan-European specialty exams (UEMS collaboration)
  - a. ESEGH (European Specialty Exam in Gastroenterology and Hepatology)
  - b. ESENeph (European Specialty Exam in Nephrology).
- c. All mandatory in UK training, and also used around the world
