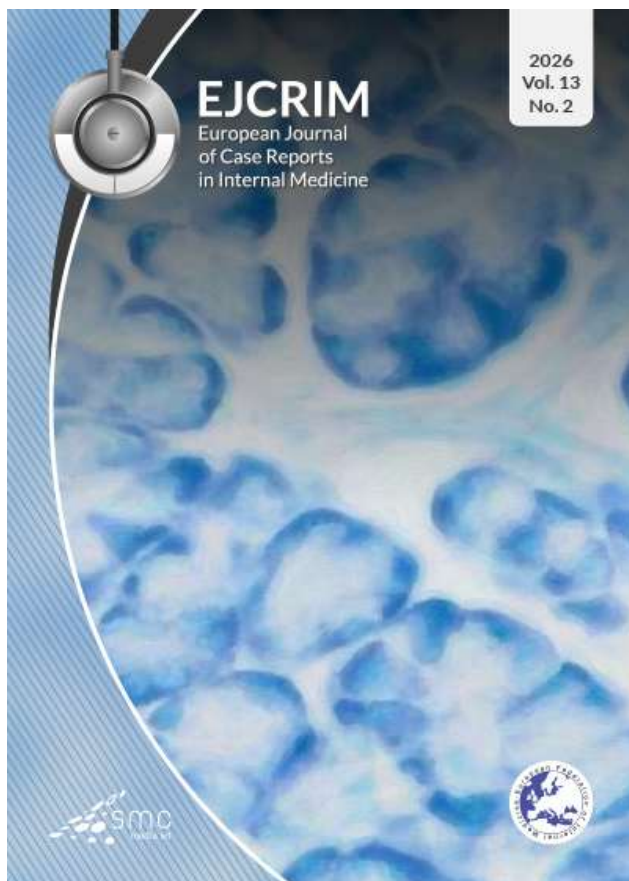

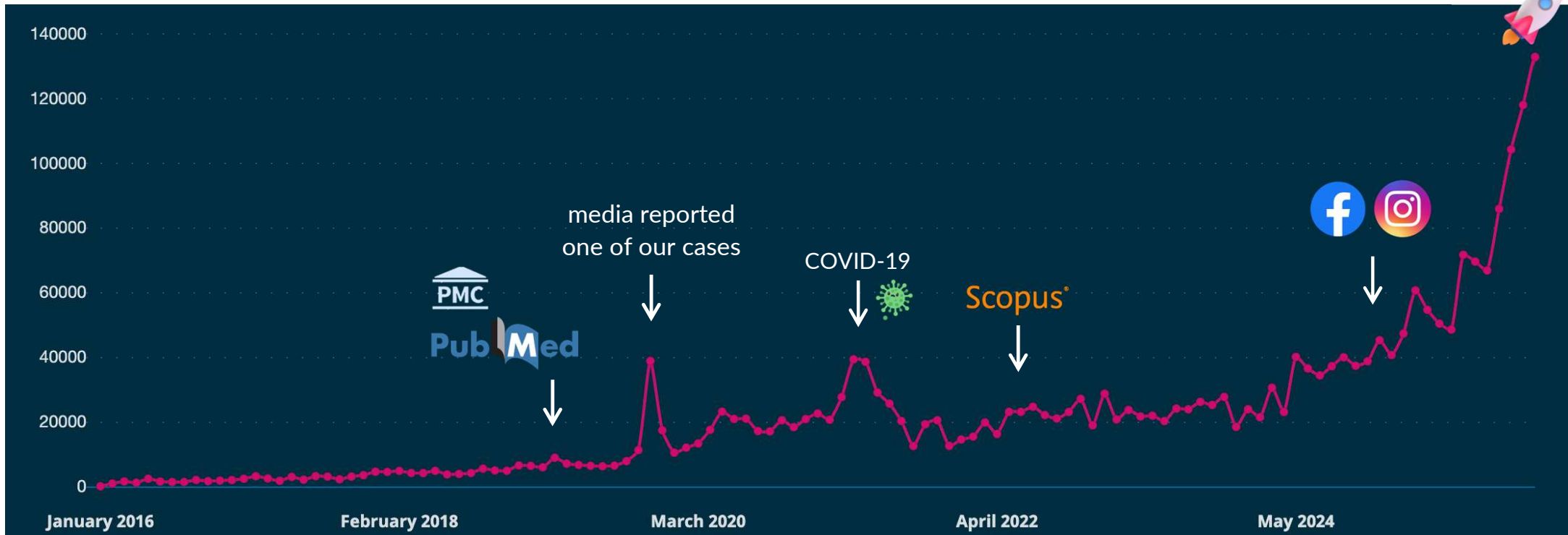

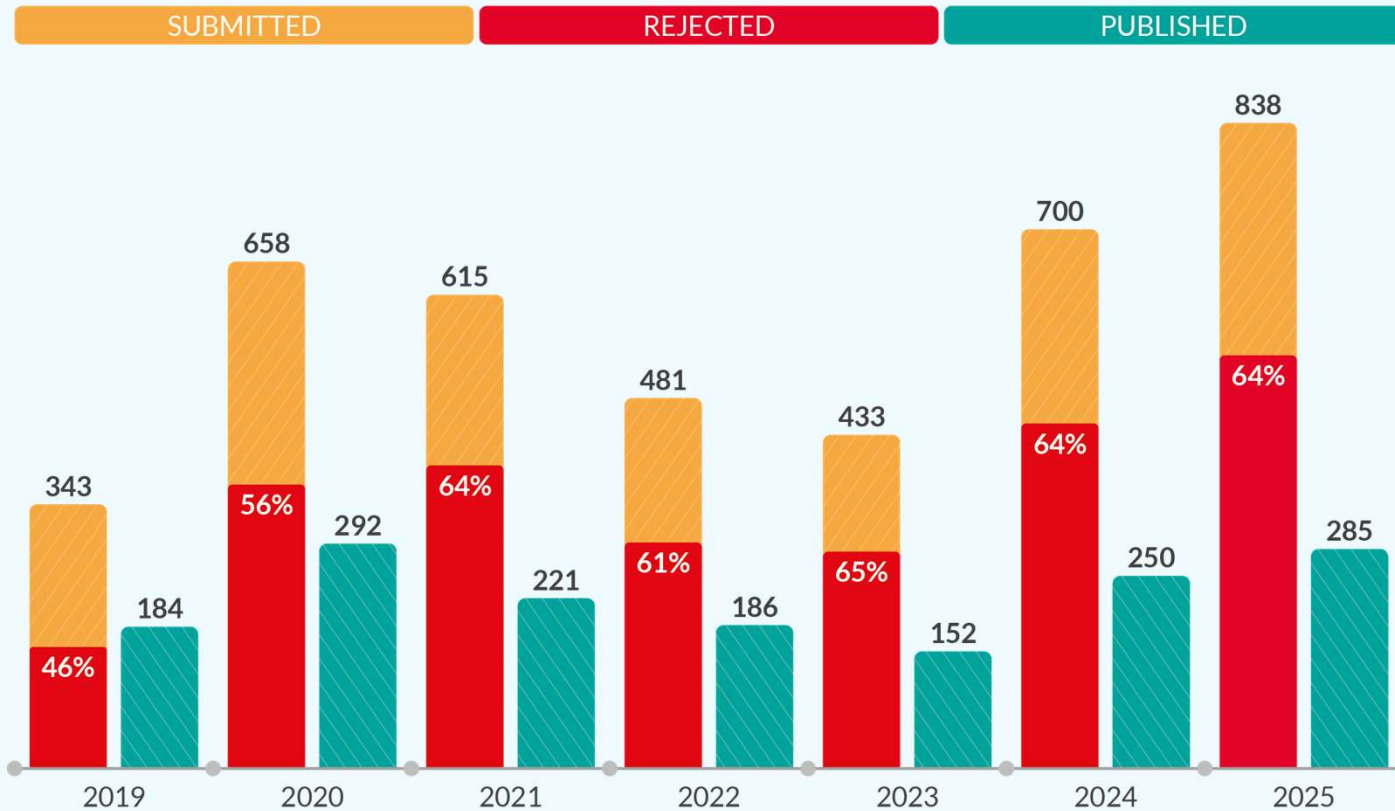
JOURNAL PERFORMANCE (2016-2026 article views)

Following the COVID-19 surge, we experienced a decline in submissions in 2022 and 2023

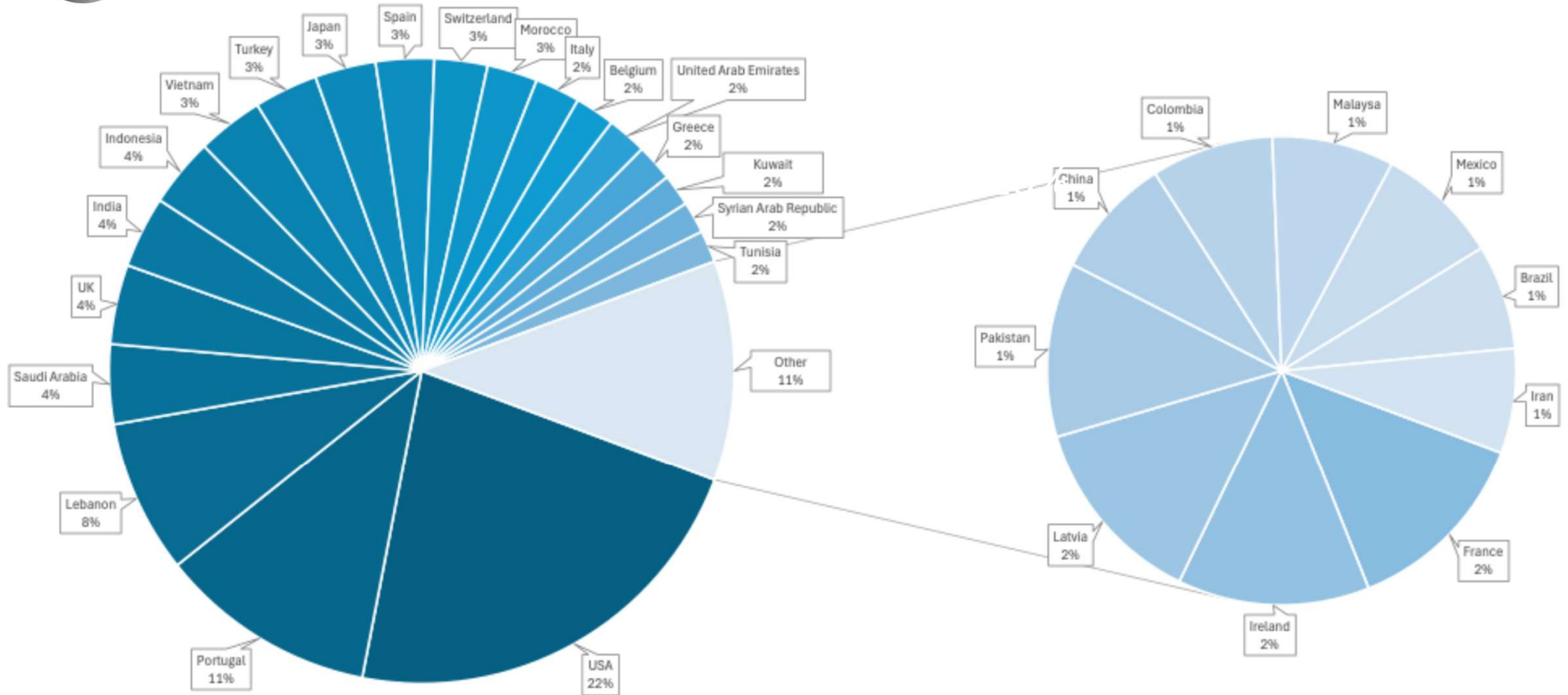
In 2024, we've received and evaluate more cases than in the COVID-years

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF AUTHORS

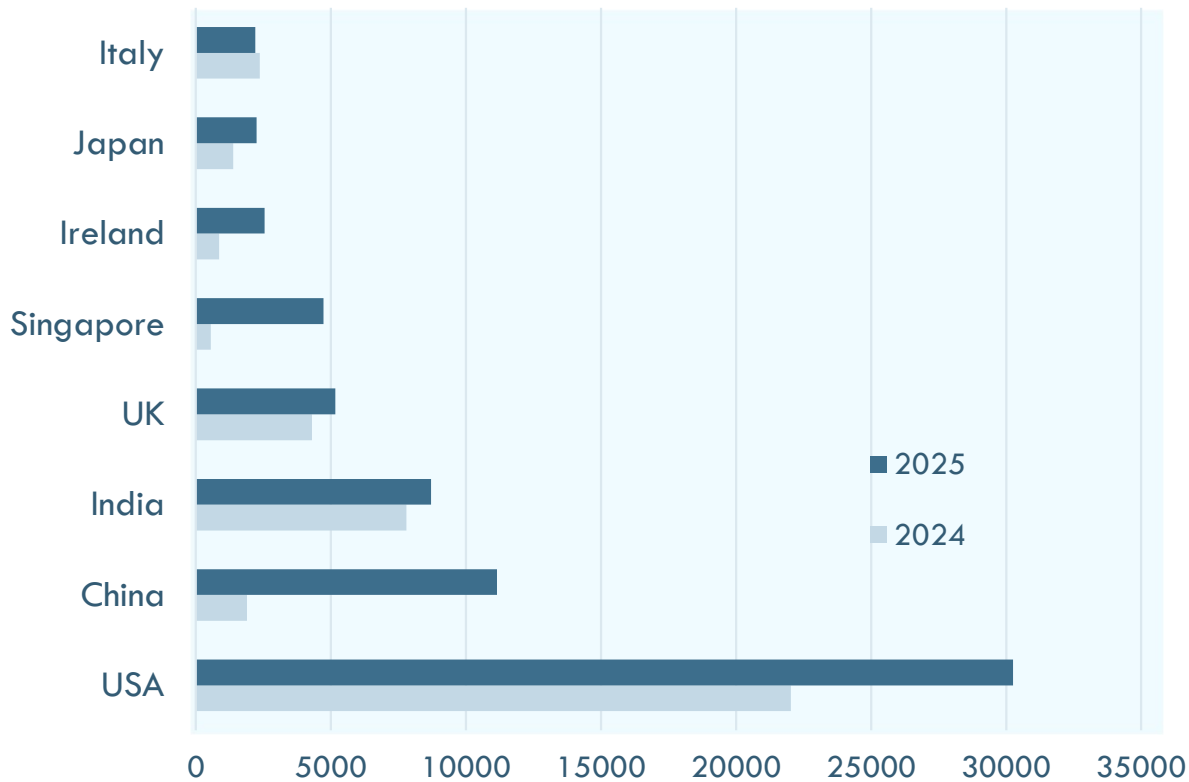

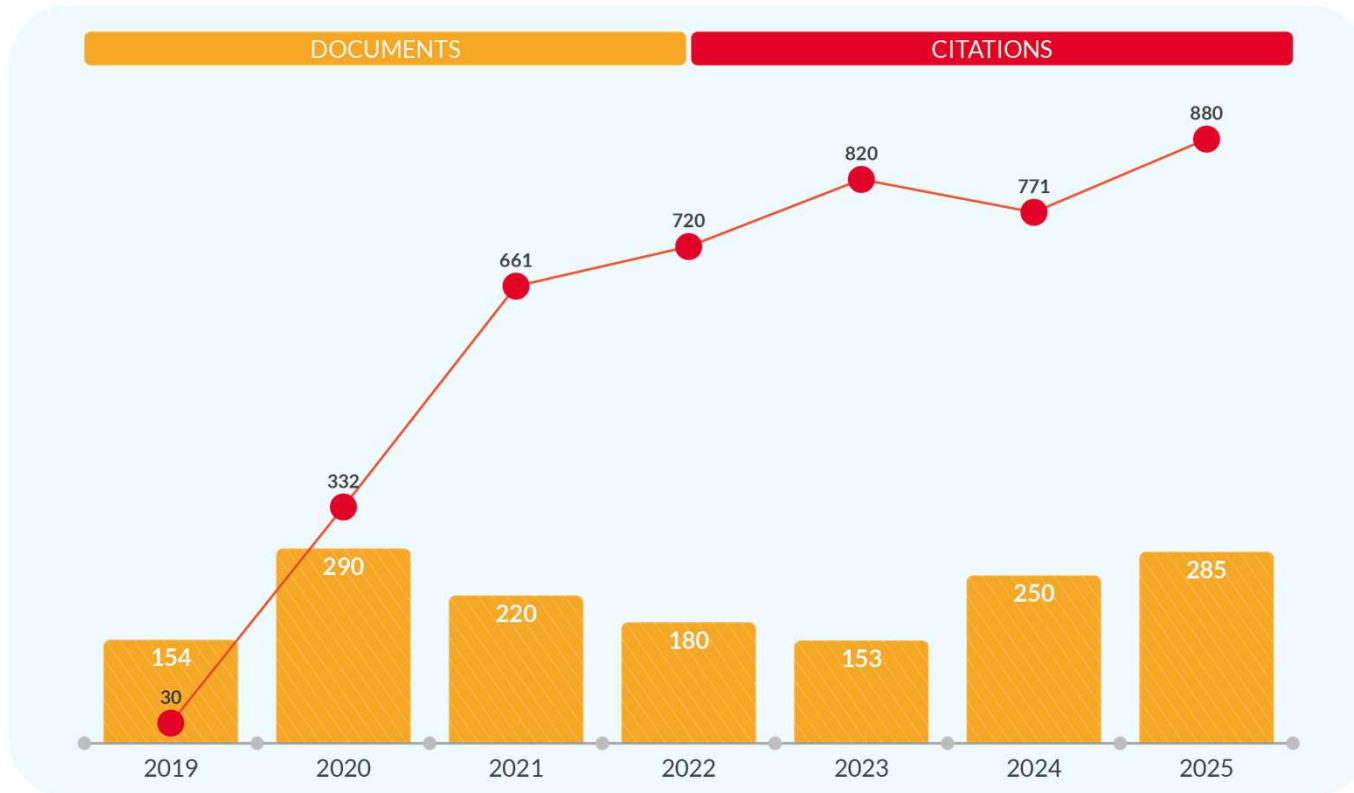

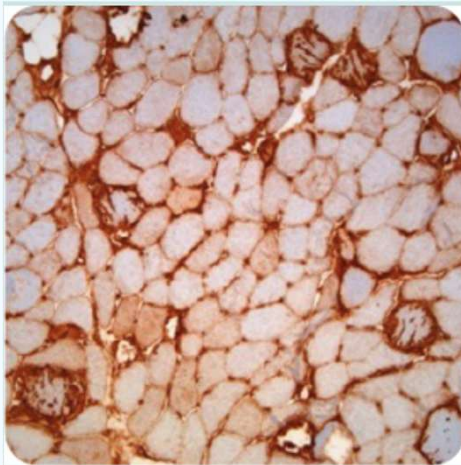
