 healthcare professionals and patients on SAD, by facilitating the mobility of
 expertise
- ✓ To coordinate studies aimed at developing new approach to SAD;
- ✓ To support campaign aimed at raising public awareness of SAD in the EFIM
 Countries;
- ✓ To provide comprehensive quality information to SAD community;
- ✓ To strengthen relationship with patients' organizations with SAD.
